Board members follow up meeting with Attorney Jeffery Lasman cancelled. To be rescheduled by Gary Stecker. The Mattson s'at 8950 ACC have graciously offered to allow us to have the **next month s 7/10/04 (Sat)**

<u>9:00am</u> - open board discussion on their shaded open lot. Attendance is requested as to keep all neighbors informed in neighborhood news.

ACC requested that there be a 45 day turnaround for Request made to the ACC. Neighbors must submit plans prior to work being started. Some request are being submitted to late for the ACC to review and act in a timely manner. The ACC meeting once every 30 days.

Old Business:

Review of **Motion:** on payment of dues on undeveloped lots.

To date 6/12/04 there are 32 FOR signatures. The required amount of signatures is 35 or 2/3 of the community. Anyone interested in signing the petition should contact Tom Martinez at 8930 ACC.

Review of <u>Motion</u>: to amend Article VII, General Covenants and Restrictions, page21, section 6, last sentence **from**: (No above-ground swimming pools, free-standing storage sheds or outbuildings, screening or front porches or garages, antennas or solar collectors are permitted on any lot)

To: (Free-standing storage sheds or out buildings are permitted with the following limitations)

- 1) Appearance shall be similar in appearance and utilize the same color scheme as the house.
- 2) Structure shall be maintained in such a manner as to preserve a like new appearance.
- 3) Structure shall be of frame or block construction.

Status: To date 6/12/04 there is 45 votes FOR and 2 votes AGAINST. The required amount of signatures for passing is 35 or 2/3 of the community. (*Status-Passed*)

To: (if above motion passes to amend item 3 to also state Structure may be made of metal, provided it is contained inside a fence)

Status: To date 6/12/04 there is 6 votes FOR and 39 votes AGAINST. The required amount of signatures for passing is 35 or 2/3 of the community. (*Status-Rejected*)

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To: (if above motion passes to amend item 3 to also state Structure may be made of plastic, preferably Rubbermaid, provided it is contained inside a fence)

Status: To date 6/12/04 there is 9 votes FOR and 33 votes AGAINST. The required amount of signatures is for passing is 35 or 2/3 of the community. (*Status-Rejected*)

Review of <u>Motion</u>: to amend Article VII, General covenants and Restrictions, page21, section 6, next to the last sentence **from**:

(No storm doors or screen doors are permitted on the front door of any dwelling)

To: (Full view storm doors are permitted on the front door of any dwelling. The definition of full view is: The frame portion of the storm door may not be wider than tree inches. Absolutely no storm doors with kick plates will be allowed) (If screens are to be used, all screens for full view doors must be outfitted or retrofitted with iffvisible screen inaterial. (Storm doors are to match the color of the front door trim)

(Approval from the ACC prior to installations is REQUIRED)

Status: To date 6/12/04 there is 36 votes FOR and 10 votes AGAINST. The required amount of signatures for passing is 35 or 2/3 of the community. (*Status-Passed*)
